

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session March 14th, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor David Robinson was present. Alderman John Finlayson was with his wife awaiting the birth of their first child and could not be present at this meeting. All other Aldermen were present as follows: Maurice Hamm, Paul Simpson, John Smith and Harry Smith.

Billy Joe Glover was present and opened the meeting with oral prayer.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to accept the minutes. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by Harry Smith to accept the financial statement. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to approve the request of Fire Chief Dillingham to make application for a grant to upgrade SCBA equipment. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to change engineering firms on the Hwy 64 Water Relocation project from Griggs and Maloney to TLM Associates. Motion 2nd by John Smith. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Maurice Hamm to approve the application to Rural Development for financing of the Hwy 64 West Project and Water Filtration System. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. Roll Call: John Finlayson—Absent, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—No, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to approve and authorize Mayor Robinson to award the bid for a flashing caution light at Falcon Rd and Hwy 45 Bypass and to sign any and all necessary documents for the project. Motion seconded by John Smith. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to grant approval and authorization to Mayor Robinson for renovating Selmer City Hall. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All four voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to request TDOT to lower speed limits from Poplar Ave at the bypass to the intersection of US 64 and US 45. Motion seconded by Maurice Hamm. All four voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to award the audit contract to Williams, Jerrols, Godwin & Nichols, PLLC for the FY 2006 Audit. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All four voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to honor the request of Willard Summers asking that the town write a letter to Mr. Gerald Nicely at State Department of Transportation to grant permission to erect a sign at Hwy 64 and Hwy 45 intersection to better advertise his Bed and Breakfast. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All four voted yes. Motion carried.

Billy Joe Glover presented a drawing depicting a drainage problem between Sunset and Sunrise Cove and asked that the town work out something to help with the problem behind his home. The Board agreed to look into the problem.
