

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session June 13, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall.

Mayor David Robinson opened in prayer followed by a request for Molly Smith Cherry to lead in the pledge of allegiance to the American Flag that followed.

The minutes were approved with no deletions or additions.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to accept the Financial Report. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Maurice Hamm and seconded by John Smith to pass on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading an ordinance to amend the Town of Selmer Municipal Code Title 2, Chapter 3, to abolish the Selmer Utility Board. John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith ----yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading Ordinance No. 534 Passed.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading an ordinance to amend the town of Selmer Municipal Code Title 2, Chapter 2, to abolish the Civil Defense Corps. John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes, Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading Ordinance No. 535 Passed.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to amend the Town of Selmer Municipal Code Title 2, Chapter 1, to abolish the Recreation Commission. John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading Ordinance No 536 Passed.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by Maurice Hamm to pass on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading an ordinance establishing the Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Fees for the Town of Selmer. John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson---yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading Ordinance No. 537 passed.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to adopt the FY 2006-2007 Budget for the Town of Selmer, Tennessee. John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes, Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading Ordinance No 538 passed.

Mr. Willard Summers addressed the Mayor and Board concerning another request for placing signs to better direct tourist to his new Bed and Breakfast. He shared his displeasure concerning what he felt was a perpetual lack of desire to promote business and working relationships within McNairy County. He referenced a news article written about his establishment in an effort to further depict the comparison of McNairy County's local newspaper, "Independent Appeal", and Alcorn County's, "Daily Corinthian."

Mayor Robinson opened the floor for action concerning Mr. Summers' request. No one spoke for or against the issue. Mr. Summers left the room later to return requesting clarification concerning a possible need to rescind past actions of the Board if it were at this point undesirable. He was told that no action was necessary, and Mr. Summers again departed from the City Hall meeting.

Motion by John Smith to approve the nomination of Robert Shackleford, Harry Smith, and Carol Ann Woods to serve on the Selmer McNairy County Industrial Development Board. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by Harry Smith to pass on 1<sup>st</sup> reading and ordinance to amend the current Zoning Ordinance for the Town of Selmer. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to adopt the TEAC Resolution authorizing the purchase of Natural Gas from the Tennessee Energy Acquisition corporation; approving the execution

and delivery of a Natural Gas supply agreement relating to the purchase; and consenting to the assignment of certain obligations under the Natural Gas Supply Agreement in connection with the issuance of Bonds by the Tennessee Energy Acquisition Corporation. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to pass a resolution establishing a Farmer's Market in Selmer. Motion seconded by John Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Maurice Hamm to add ASMS to the approved list of certified entities offering a driver's education course to those in need. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to amend the Police Department's Promotion Policy to allow for an appointment of an Assistant Chief of Police. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to authorize the Chief of Police to enter into and become a signatory to the West Tennessee Methamphetamine Task Force Agreement. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Maurice Hamm to adopt a resolution as requested and written by Paul Simpson to send to the family of John R. Tackett giving recognition for Mr. Tackett's past educational services. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.
