

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session July 11, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. in Selmer City Hall. Present was Mayor David Robinson. Present as Board of Aldermen, John Finlayson, Maurice Hamm, Paul Simpson, John Smith, and Harry Smith. Rev. Clifford Wynn of Cypress Creek First Baptist Church opened with prayer.

There were no deletions or additions to the minutes.

Motion by Paul Simpson to accept the financial statement. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to accept the recommendation of Police Chief Neal Burks in hiring Anita Mayhall as a police officer. Motion seconded by Maurice Hamm. All voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to accept Recreational Director Sybil Dancer's request in adopting a fee schedule for rental of pavilions in the park and a policy for non-profit Community Center rentals. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to pass on 2nd reading an ordinance to amend the current Zoning Ordinance for the Town of Selmer. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith---yes. Motion carried. Ordinance 539 passed. (Public Hearing-No one spoke for or against.)

Motion by Paul Simpson to declare certain Street and Sanitation equipment as surplus properties to be included with the Drug and Police Department's fall auction sale. Motion seconded by Maurice Hamm. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to adopt on first reading an ordinance to amend the FY 2005/2006 Budget. Motion seconded by Maurice Hamm. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to ratify Private Charter No. 126, House Bill 4091 enacted by the 104th General Assembly of the State of Tennessee approving changes to the Charter of the Town of Selmer, Tennessee. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. Roll call: John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—No, John Smith—yes. Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried. Charter Ratified.

Motion by John Finlayson to adopt on first reading an ordinance amending the court cost relative to fines and penalties, Title 3, Chapter 1, Section 3-108 of the Selmer Municipal Code. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to change the probation requirement within the Police Department from 90 days to 6 months. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Chris Tull and Rodney Murray were present. Chris complained and questioned the status of a trailer on Plum Street and several properties adjoining Circle Hill Drive. He was informed of the current action to renovate.
