

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Present and presiding was Mayor David Robinson. Board of Aldermen present: John Finlayson, Maurice Hamm, Paul Simpson, John Smith, and Harry Smith.

Rev. Ray Burks opened with scripture from Proverbs Chapter 3 followed by prayer. There were no deletions or additions to the minutes.

Motion by Harry Smith to accept the financial statement. Motion seconded by Maurice Hamm. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to hire Justin Powers as the new police officer as recommended by Police Chief Neal Burks. Motion seconded by John Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on second reading the Ordinance amending the 2005/2006 Budget. Roll call: John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried. Ordinance No. 240 passed.

Motion by John Smith to pass on second reading an Ordinance amending Title 3, Chapter 1 Section 3-108 of the Selmer Municipal Code relative to court fines, penalties and costs. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. Roll call: John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried. Ordinance No. 241 passed.

Motion by Paul Simpson to pass on first reading the Ordinance to amend Title 18 of the Selmer Municipal Code by adding a Chapter on Water System Cross Connections. (This ordinance was passed September 5<sup>th</sup> 1975 but failed to be reprinted in the latest Code.) Motion seconded by John Smith. Roll call: John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith--yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to pass on first reading an Ordinance to raise the Sales and Use Tax in the Town of Selmer from 2.25% to 2.75% for a period of 24 months to repair and improve Park and Recreation facilities, and to request a referendum of the people to approve the ordinance. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. Roll Call: John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—No, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on first reading an ordinance amending the FY 2007 annual operating Budget and Capital Program for the Town of Selmer. Roll Call: John Finlayson—yes Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried.

Chris Tull presented pictures of unsightly properties on Circle Hill Drive to Attorney Abernathy and to the Mayor and Board requesting that the areas be cleaned up.

Meeting Adjourned. Beer Board to Follow.

Selmer Beer Board was called into session following the 7:00 p.m. August 8<sup>th</sup> 2006 Mayor and Board of Aldermen meeting in Selmer City Hall.

Presiding was Mayor David Robinson. Board members present were:

Motion by Paul Simpson and second by Harry Smith to grant Betty Ann Sparkman a beer Permit to sell packaged beer for off premises consumption at Selmer Quick Stop, 430 Peach Ave. (North Y), Selmer, Tennessee. Roll Call: John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—No, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried. Permit granted.

Motion by Maurice Hamm to penalize Flash Market for the violation of selling Beer to minors as enacted at the December 2005 Beer Board meeting and again call for suspension of Flash Market's Beer Permit for a 90 day period beginning 12.01 A.M., August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

Motion seconded by Harry Smith. Motion amended by Paul Simpson to call for a 60-day suspension for Flash Market instead of the 90-day suspension. Amend failed for lack of a second.

Roll call on the motion to suspend Flash Market's Beer Permit for a 90-day period beginning 12:01 A.M. August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2006. John Finlayson—yes, Maurice Hamm—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. Motion carried.
