

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session November 14th, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Present were: Mayor David Robinson. Board of Aldermen John Finlayson, Maurice Hamm, Paul Simpson, John Smith, and Harry Smith.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Rev Ben Lutrell, of Cumberland Presbyterian Church, 234 Court Ave., Selmer, Tn.

Ms Chelsea Rhodes of Selmer Middle School and president of Student Government Association lead everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag.

There were no deletions or additions to the minutes.

Motion by Maurice Hamm and seconded by John Finlayson to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to place Timothy Lynn Ingle in a full- time police officer's position as recommended by Police Chief Neal Burks as doing a fine job and having completed his probationary period. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Mayor Robinson stated that there would be a public hearing at the 6:00 p.m. regular Tuesday night Planning Commission meeting, November 21, 2006 in Selmer City Hall for the purpose of discussing rezoning Shanna Drive, Tull Street and Mitchell Drive.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by John Smith to adopt a resolution adopting a "125 Cafeteria Plan" for pre-taxing insurance deductions for employees. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to adopt on first reading an ordinance to amend the Town of Selmer Municipal Code Title 15, Chapter 1, Section 15-128, to repeal the automobile and truck registration fee known in the past as the requirement for an "Auto Tag." Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Alderman Simpson paid complement to Alderman John Smith.

Chris Tull asked when the sixty day grace period for cleaning up certain properties on Circle Hill Drive would be over. Attorney Abernathy and Building Inspector Jim Replogle reported on the procedure. Chris also questioned if there had been issuance of a certificate of occupancy on a now occupied thought to have been condemned trailer in the same area.
