

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session December 12th, 2006 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall.

Present were: Mayor David Robinson

Aldermen: Maurice Hamm, John Smith, and Harry Smith.

Absent: John Finlayson and Paul Simpson.

The prayer was given by Rev. Dr. Freed Ware pastor of Faith Baptist Church of Selmer. The pledge of allegiance to the United States flag was led by Tyler Stanfield presently attending the 8th grade in Selmer Middle School.

There were no deletions or additions to the minutes.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by Maurice Hamm to accept the financial statement. All three voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by Maurice Hamm to pass on second reading an Ordinance repealing the old Auto Tag by amending the Town of Selmer Municipal Code Title 15, Chapter 1, Section 15-128, to repeal the automobile and truck registration fee. Maurice Hamm—yes, John Smith—yes, Harry Smith—yes. John Finlayson--Absent, Paul Simpson—Absent. Motion carried. 2nd reading passed on Ordinance No. 549.

Mayor Robinson called for the second reading of a proposed Ordinance which would rezone properties bound by the Highway 45 By-pass in the West, Circle Hill Drive in the North and East, and Mockingbird Drive and U.S. Highway 64 in the South, encompassing Tull St., Shanna Drive and Mitchell Street from R-1 (Low Density Residential) to R-2 (Medium Density Residential). The Roll was called as follows: Maurice Hamm—No, John Smith—No, Harry Smith—No, John Finlayson—Absent, Paul Simpson--Absent. Ordinance Failed.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by John Smith to adopt the revised Purchasing Policy for the Town of Selmer. All three present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by Harry Smith to adopt the revised Promotion Policy for the Selmer Police Department. All three present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith to adopt a Sobriety Checkpoint Policy for Selmer Police Department. All three voted yes. Motion carried.

The Meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:10 P.M. and The Selmer Beer Board was called into session.
