

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall, October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2007. Mayor David Robinson presided. All Board of Aldermen were present as follows: John Finlayson, Maurice Hamm, Paul Simpson, John Smith and Harry Smith.

Prayer was recited by Rev. Luke Delavergne of Eastside Church of Christ. The pledge of allegiance was led by Mayor Robinson's son DZ Robinson presently attending the 7<sup>th</sup> grade at Selmer Middle School.

There were no deletions or additions to the minutes.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by Maurice Hamm to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by Maurice Hamm to accept the recommendation of Police Chief Neal Burks by officially accepting Bradley Huckabee as a full time police officer having successfully completed his 6 month probationary period. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to adopt on second reading an ordinance to amend Title 16, Chapter 1, Section 16-110, of the Selmer Municipal Code relative to parades in the Town of Selmer. All five voted yes. Motion carried Ordinance No. 567 passed.

Motion by Harry Smith and seconded by Maurice to adopt on second reading an ordinance amending the text of the Selmer Municipal Zoning Ordinance defining Bed & Breakfast home stay operations and allowing these operations in specific Residential Districts as special exceptions not to include the R-1 zone. Motion by John Smith to table this action until more study could be given by the planning commission to consider all pros and cons in allowing a Bed and Breakfast in the R-1 zone. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All voted yes to table the action until further study by the planning commission. Motion to table carried.

Motion by Maurice Hamm to adopt a resolution approving an increase in the amount of \$10,000 to the Joint Economic and Community Development Board for three years. Motion 2<sup>nd</sup> by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to adopt on 1<sup>st</sup> reading an ordinance amending the text of the Selmer Municipal zoning Ordinance Chapter XII Provisions for Flood Hazard Districts correcting cross-references. Motion seconded by Harry Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.
