

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session April 8th, 2008 in Selmer City Hall. Present were: Mayor David Robinson. Board of Aldermen: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, Lloyd Dean Tennyson.

Homer Watson Associate Pastor of Cypress Creek First Baptist Church gave the prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag was led by Weston Ferguson a Selmer Middle School 5th Grader.

The minutes were approved. Motion by Paul Simpson to accept the financial statement. Motion seconded by Lloyd Dean Tennyson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to accept the recommendation of Recreation Director Sybil Dancer by approving the appointment of Carolyn Simmons and Harold Knight to two year terms on the Recreational Board replacing Danny Roberts Jr. and Tony Robinson. Motion seconded by Lloyd Dean Tennyson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Mayor Robinson presented Fire Chief Dillingham with a plaque for his outstanding achievements in being recognized as Executive Fire Officer.

Anthony Knight requested permission to erect a permanent memorial for Cars for Kids victims to be erected in the park at no expense to the Town of Selmer.

Motion by Paul Simpson to grant Anthony Knight and his committee authorization to erect a permanent memorial for the injured and dead victims resulting from the Saturday June 16th, 2007 "Cars for Kids" tragedy with further authorization for the town to do whatever can be done to help. Motion seconded by Edward Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to pass on 2nd reading an Ordinance to amend Title 9, Chapter 9 of the Selmer Municipal Code regulating yard sales. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd reading passed. Ordinance No. 570 passed.

Motion by Paul Simpson to pass a Resolution adopting a schedule of fees pertaining to Title 10 Chapter 1 & 2 of the Selmer Municipal Code. (Animal Control) Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to pass on first reading an ordinance to amend Title 10, Chapter 2, Section 10-205 of the Selmer Municipal Code. (Citation pertaining to noisy dogs) Motion seconded by Edward Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to pass on first reading an Ordinance to amend Title 10, Chapter 2, Section 10-204 of the Selmer Municipal Code pertaining to keeping Pit Bulls within the corporate limits of the Town of Selmer. (Animal Control) Motion seconded by Edward Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to pass a resolution amending the Town of Selmer Personnel Policy pertaining to Sick Pay. Motion seconded by Lloyd Dean Tennyson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Finlayson to approve the TEAC Management Agreement for a three year period. Motion seconded by John Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Mayor David Robinson asked that his appointments of Jason Speth and Wes Harrison to the Municipal Regional Planning Commission be affixed within the minutes. (Appointments within the Urban Growth Boundary area)

Motion by Paul Simpson to approve the FY 2007- 2008 audit agreement with Williams, Jerrolds, Godwin & Nichols Certified Public Accountants. Motion seconded by Lloyd Dean Tennyson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.
