

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session April 14th, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor David Robinson was present. Board of Aldermen was present as follows: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, and Lloyd Tennyson.

Motion by Paul Simpson and 2nd by Lloyd Tennyson to accept the financial statement. All voted yes. Motion carried.

Tina Churchwell of McNairy County Humane Society gave a presentation to the board asking that the funds which had been donated to the McNairy County Humane Society through an addition on the donator's Utility bill be released to them by the Selmer Utility Department. She answered questions concerning the operation and presented the Mayor and Board written detail of present activities. The Utility Department was instructed to give the McNairy Co Humane Society the donations.

Motion by Lloyd Tennyson to approve the requested lease for a copy machine as requested by the Utility Department. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to approve on first reading an ordinance amending the text of the Selmer Municipal Zoning governing periphery buffering and screening as well as Waste Containment, Waste Disposal and Raw material storage in M-1 (Industrial) and Special-Impact Industrial S-1 Districts. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed.

Motion by John Smith to approve on first reading an ordinance amending the text of the Selmer Municipal Zoning Ordinance governing Mobile Home location and provisions relating to Mobile Home Parks. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed.
