

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session March 9, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor David Robinson and all five Board of Aldermen were present as follows: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, and Lloyd Dean Tennyson.

The meeting opened with prayer by Rev. Mark Thompson of First Baptist Church, Selmer. Miss Brenna Anderson led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag. The minutes were approved.

Motion by Lloyd Tennyson and seconded by Edward Smith to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by Lloyd Tennyson to adopt the audit agreement with Williams, Jerrolds, Godwin & Nichols for FY 2010. John Finlayson---yes, Paul Simpson—yes, Edward Smith—yes, John Smith—no, and Lloyd Tennyson—yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Edward Smith to approve a new copier lease for the Civic Center from the State of Tennessee contractor's list at a price of \$116.00 per month instead of the presently being paid \$158.00 per month. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. Motion carried.

Paul Simpson asked that Mr. Jimmy Dickey be remembered for his serving four years as Aldermen from 1992 thru 1995, once as interim Fire Chief, Pickwick Electric Board, as well as many other civic contributions and services within Selmer and McNairy County. Mr. Dickey's funeral will be at First Baptist Church, followed by burial tomorrow, March 10th, 2010.
