

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session May 11th, 2010 at 7: 00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall.

Mayor David Robinson was present along with all five Board of Aldermen as follows: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, Lloyd Tennyson.

The meeting opened with prayer by Pastor Jeff Miller of Friendship Church followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag led by Ms. Jaycee Miller.

The minutes were approved and it was moved by Paul Simpson and seconded by Lloyd Tennyson to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

The tornado of Sunday May 2, 2010 had done much damage along a strip north of the North Y intersection including the Selmer Utilities Department main building and warehouse. FEMA and TEMA representatives were present. Henry of FEMA explained their role in assisting individuals on a case basis. He said that it was unbelievable how well Selmer's Fire & Rescue, Police, and Emergency Management had organized and handled the relief operations and that he was certainly going to pass the information concerning how well all had gone to other areas as well as to the Federal level in an effort to teach others.

Fire Chief Anthony Carr explained two very minor items that caused the Selmer to miss the AFG , Assistance to Fire Fighters Grant, which was approximately a \$300,000 grant. Chief Carr asked for approval to reapply for this years "AFG" with a possible match of up to \$15,000 for a Fire Truck and Rescue Grant.

Motion by Paul Simpson to reapply for the AFG, Assistance to Fire Fighters Grant, as requested by Chief Carr. Motion seconded by Edward Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to pass on 2nd reading an Ordinance adopting the 2009 International Building Codes and 2009 International Residential Codes with no increased fee schedule. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd reading passed. Ordinance No. 590 passed.

Motion by Edward Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on 2nd reading an Ordinance allowing Repair Services, including Automobile Body Shops in the B-1, M-1, and S-1 districts. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd reading passed. Ordinance No. 591 passed.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on 1st reading the Water Additive Accountability Ordinance. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on 1st reading an Ordinance to rezone parcels 3, 4, & 5 of Group A, McNairy County Tax Map 89C, control map 80, as updated April 2006 between circle Hill Drive and Peach Ave from B-1 (General Business) to R-2 (Medium Density Residential). All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Edward Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to pass on 1st reading an Ordinance amending the 2009-2010 Budget. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Finlayson and seconded by John Smith to pass on 1st reading an Ordinance amending the 2010-2011 Budget and adopting the 2010 property tax rate as reduced by the new assessment from the current \$ 0.88 cents to \$0.86 cents to retain the same revenue. All five voted yes. Motion carried.
