

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session June 8, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Present: Mayor David Robinson. Board of Aldermen members, John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, and Lloyd Tennyson.

Rev. Freed Ware of Faith Baptist Church opened with prayer. Judge Bill Webb led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag.

Minutes approved.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on second reading the Water Additive Accountability Ordinance. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading passed. Ordinance No 592 adopted.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Smith to pass on second reading the Ordinance to rezone parcels 3,4,& 5 of Group A, McNairy County Tax Map 89C, control map 80, as updated April 2006 between Circle Hill Drive and Peach Ave from B-1 (General Business) to R-2 (Medium Density Residential). All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading passed. Ordinance No 593 adopted.

Motion by Lloyd Tennyson and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Edward Smith to pass on second reading the Ordinance amending the 2009-2010 Budget. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2<sup>nd</sup> reading passes. Ordinance No 594 adopted.

Paul Simpson explained that he had not wanted to close the exit to Glover Drive and that they had exhausted all efforts for the past year with the State Department of Transportation to achieve an additional access for the industrial park and UT without closing the Glover Drive exit as it presently is. He further stated that he hated to do it but that there appeared to be no alternative means to get the desired additional ramp without the close.

Motion by Paul Simpson to succumb to TDOT in closing the existing by-pass entrance of Glover Dr., and contact the Tennessee Department of Transportation so that the needed school and industrial entrance ramp may get underway. Motion seconded by Edward Smith. Roll Call: John Finlayson—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, Edward Smith---yes, John Smith---yes, Lloyd Tennyson---no. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by Edward Smith to approve the Bank of McNairy County (Bank of Fayette County) as an official depository for Town of Selmer funds. Roll call: John Finlayson—passed, Paul Simpson—yes, Edward Smith—yes, John Smith—yes, Lloyd Tennyson—yes. Motion carried.

Earlier in the meeting Michael Linton, Contract Manager for the CAT -5 Disaster Services, 395 Keystone Lane, Morris Chapel, TN 38361 addressed the Mayor and Board concerning the termination of his contract to remove debris resulting from the May 2,

2010 tornado. Mr. Linton questioned the basis of his termination and the time that the decision was determined resulting in a termination letter given him at approximately 1:30 p.m. today. Attorney Abernathy advised Mayor Robinson not to argue with Mr. Linton during this meeting. No further discussion other than a comment from Jeff Sisk from the audience transpired.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Smith to award the contract to Outdoors Unlimited to remove debris resulting from the May 2, 2010 tornado. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to reopen bids for employee Health Insurance with the Board having approval prior to any change. The bid deadline was set at 2:00 p.m. June 17, 2010. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned.
