

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session November 9, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor David Robinson was present. All five aldermen were present as follows: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, and Lloyd Tennyson.

The meeting opened with prayer by Pastor Gregg Worthey of First Christian Church followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag led by Judge Bill Webb.

Motion was made by Paul Simpson and seconded by Lloyd Tennyson to accept the minutes and financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by Edward Smith to approve and adopt a Resolution awarding the construction contract for the Downtown Water Project to Marbury Construction Co., LLC, 79 Vester Taylor Rd, Denmark, Tn 38391 in the amount of \$1,169,339.50. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Edward Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to approve a Resolution authorizing the filing of the 2011 Housing grant. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to approve the Christmas Parade permit. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to approve the Dr. Martin Luther King Parade permit. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.
