

The Town of Selmer Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session at 7:00 P.M., June 14th, 2011 in Selmer City Hall.

Present: Mayor David Robinson

Board of Aldermen: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith,
John Smith, Lloyd Tennyson.

The minutes were approved and a motion was made by Lloyd Tennyson to approve the financial statement. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Terry Burns for the McNairy Board of Education requested \$2,500 for the "One to One Program". Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to budget the request to the One to One Program". Roll call: John Finlayson—yes, Paul Simpson—no, Edward Smith—no, John Smith—yes, Lloyd Tennyson--no. Motion failed.

Mayor Robinson was pleased to announce that Abb Chambers had donated to the town a piece of property on Purdy Rd joining the Dixie Property. The Board expressed appreciation for the property.

Motion by Lloyd Tennyson and seconded by Edward Smith to pass on second reading the FY 2012 Town of Selmer Budget Ordinance and the 2011 Property Tax Rate of \$0.806 per \$100.00 assessment remaining the same as the 2010.

All five voted yes. Motion carried. Ordinance No. 602 passed.

Motion by John Finlayson to approve the audit contract of Williams, Jerrolds, Godwin & Nichols, PLLC as auditors for FY 2010-2011. Motion seconded by Lloyd Tennyson. John Finlayson—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, Edward Smith—yes, John Smith—no, Lloyd Tennyson—yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by Edward Smith to approve a 10% reduction in the natural gas rate effective in the July 2011 billing. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson to approve the donation of Abb Chambers for the lot on Purdy Rd. that joins the recently purchased Dixie property. Motion seconded by Edward Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Paul Simpson as follows: "Pursuant to Section 18 of the Town of Selmer Charter and due to the incapacity of Judge Bill Webb to serve as the Town Judge, I move that Attorney Ken Seaton be appointed as Judge Pro Tem to serve until Bill Webb is able to resume his duties as Town Judge, or in the event he is unable to resume his duties as Town Judge, the Mayor and Board will appoint a permanent Judge."

Motion seconded by John Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to authorize approval for Mayor Robinson to negotiate alternatives for local planning services for the town and present the findings back. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Edward Smith to approve Outdoor Unlimited bid for Right of Way maintenance for FY 2012 & 2013. Motion seconded by John Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to approve the parade permit for Parks & Recreation July 4th Freedom Festival. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes.

A hearing for Chris Reynolds from the Police Department and Stanley Smith from the Utilities Department was set for 6:00 June 27th, 2011.

Meeting adjourned.
A special Beer Board Hearing was called into session for violations.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met as the Selmer Beer Board following the 7:00 P.M. regular Board of Mayor and Aldermen meeting of June 14th, 2011 in Selmer City Hall for the purpose of hearing violations of selling beer to minors as presented by Selmer Police & Drug Department.

Drug Officer Teddy Roberts presented findings of selling beer to minors in the business name of Selmer BP of Fisher Oil Company and Super Mini on Hwy 64 East. Both locations had representation.

Motion by John Smith to suspend the license to sell beer for a period of only 30 days due to this being a first time offence at the Super-Mini 64 East. Motion seconded by Edward Smith. John Finlayson—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, Edward Smith—yes, John Smith—yes, Lloyd Tennyson—yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith to suspend the license of Selmer BP (Fisher Oil Company) for a period of 90 days with the beginning and ending dates of both Super-Mini and Selmer BP at the discretion of Police Chief Neal Burks. Motion seconded by Edward Smith. John Finlayson—yes, Paul Simpson—yes, Edward Smith—yes, John Smith—yes, Lloyd Tennyson—yes. Motion carried.
