

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session November 8, 2011, at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor David Robinson and all five Board of Aldermen were present as follows: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, and Lloyd Tennyson.

Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order and Rev. Terry Presson of First United Methodist Church opened with prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States Flag led by Jeff Sisk.

The minutes were approved and a motion was made by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Finlayson to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Finlayson to approve on second reading an Ordinance amending Title 9 by deleting and changing Sections 9-201 through 9-210 of the Selmer Municipal Code regarding Door to Door Vendors (Solicitors). All five voted yes. Motion carried. Ordinance No. 604 Passed.

Motion by Edward Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to pass on second reading an Ordinance amending the Selmer Municipal Zoning Ordinance for Special Events signs. All five voted yes. Motion carried. Ordinance No. 605 Passed.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by Edward Smith to pass on first reading an Ordinance amending the official Zoning Map by rezoning Map Parcel 17.01, Group C on McNairy county Tax Map 0891 along Mulberry Ave from R-1(Low Density Residential) to B-1 (General Business). All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed. (Former KFC property)

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on first reading an Ordinance amending the official Zoning Map by rezoning the properties between Pharr Ave., N 5th Street, Warren Ave. and N 6<sup>th</sup> Street from R-2 (Medium Density Residential) to R-2D (Medium Density Residential/Duplex). All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed. (Former Grace Kiser property)

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Smith to pass on first Reading an Ordinance amending Title 7, Chapter 2, of the Selmer Municipal code relative to the Fire Code. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed.

Motion by John Finlayson and seconded by Paul Simpson to pass on first reading an Ordinance amending Title 8, Chapter 2, section 8-214 of the Selmer Municipal code relative to the issuance of a Beer License within 300 Feet of a Residential dwelling. Paul Simpson---yes, Edward Smith---yes, John Smith---No, John Finlayson---yes, and Lloyd Tennyson---yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed.
