

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session August 14th, 2012 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor David Robinson was present along with and all five Board of Aldermen as follows: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith, and Chris Tull.

The meeting opened with prayer by Rev. Terry Presson of First United Methodist Church followed with the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Mr. Dennis Jackson.

A motion was made by Chris Tull to accept the minutes. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Paul Simpson and seconded by Edward Smith to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to pass on second reading an ordinance to allow solar electric facilities in the residential zones, defining and governing solar facilities. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd reading Passed. Ordinance No. 615 passed.

Motion by John Smith and second by Edward Smith to pass on first reading an ordinance amending the text of the Selmer Municipal zoning Ordinance reducing the minimum lot area for single family dwellings in R-2D districts from 6,000 sq.ft. to 5,000 sq.ft. and amending the official zoning map by rezoning the parcel 8.00, Group C, on the McNairy County tax map 89C located between Pharr Ave. and Warren Ave. along N. 7th St. from R-2 to R-2D. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed.

Motion by Paul Simpson and second by Chris Tull to approve the uniform contract as requested by Richard Ashe with Paramount Uniforms, 5421 Crestview, Memphis 38134. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Chris Tull asked that it be noted that Harvey Neal Smith brought his equipment and cleaned the ditch bank at the park and middle school making it look much nicer. Mayor Robinson said that it should also be noted that Chris Tull came with the airport equipment and sprayed the weeds helping the appearance as well.

Motion by Paul Simpson and second by John Smith to approve the request for Mayor Robinson and Richard Ashe to proceed with looking at a 15-year agreement for meter replacement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.
