

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session in Selmer City Hall at 7:00 P.M. February 12, 2013. Mayor David Robinson and four of the Board of Aldermen were present as follows: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, and John Smith. Paul Simpson was absent.

The meeting opened with prayer by Rev. Harold King of Lakeview Baptist Church followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Sybil Dancer.

The minutes were approved and a motion was made by Chris Tull and seconded by John Finlayson. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to approve the request of Fire Chief Anthony Carr to file a Fire Prevention Grant, which would have approximately a \$1,000 match. All four voted yes. Motion Carried.

Sybil Dancer announced that the depth of the planned paving for the walking trail will have to be twice as thick and costly to meet grant specification requirements and that the County and McNairy County School Board will be asked to participate. With the additional participation, the shared cost will be 10% of the 20% match...

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to approve a resolution establishing an updated Occupational Safety and Health Program Plan, (OSHA) with plans and rules that Safety Director Jim Replogle may implement. All four voted yes. Motion carried.

John Finlayson complimented Recreational Director Sybil Dancer on the success of the recent Father Daughter Dance having a big turn out of approximately 230 people.
