

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session September 10, 2013 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall.

Present were: Mayor David Robinson.

Board of Aldermen: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith,  
John Smith. Chris Tull.

The meeting opened with prayer by Rev. Terry Presson of First United Methodist Church followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Miss. Abbie Atkinson and Miss. Kirsten Kiddy.

The room was filled with champion winning baseball players.

Recreational Director Sybil Dancer proudly recognized and gave a brief summary about the three winning teams. Special congratulations and tribute was given to the team players, coaches, and assistant coaches. A special proclamation to congratulate the Selmer 12yr Old Dixie Youth Baseball team was also awarded. Selmer 12 year old Dixie Youth Baseball team coached by Josh Gray and assistant coaches David McCullar and Phillip Roberts were undefeated at the State level winning the "12 Year Old Dixie Youth State Championship" title. They were also recognized as having represented the greatest degree of character both on and off the field.

The Dixie Boys, 14 years old, coached by Danny Roberts Jr., Chris Whitten, and Chris Crabb won the Dixie Boys State Championship and went to the World Series, and the Dixie Majors Team, 19 years old team, coached by Tracy Chandler and Tim Dancer went to the World Series. It was noted that each of the nine players of this team had won the Dixie Boys Championship when they were 14 years old.

Everyone applauded their accomplishments and pictures were made with the Mayor and Board and each team and their coaches by the local newspaper.

The minutes were accepted and a motion was made by Chris Tull and seconded by Edward Smith to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Finlayson and seconded by Paul Simpson to pass on second reading an ordinance amending Title Three, Chapter One, Section 3-108 of the Selmer Municipal Code, relative to court fines, penalties and cost. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd reading passed. Ordinance No. 630 adopted.

Motion by John Smith and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on first reading an ordinance amending the text of the Selmer Municipal Zoning Ordinance Chapter XII provisions governing Signs. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1<sup>st</sup> reading passed. (This ordinance would allow a larger pole sign in the Business District.)

Motion by John Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to approve Selmer's Planning Advisory Services agreement with Chris Pate. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Chris Tull and seconded by John Finlayson to approve hiring Tim Finnell an Independent Insurance Consultant as recommended by Attorney Terry Abernathy. Aldermen Paul Simpson moved to table the action until the October meeting due to Attorney Abernathy's absence and the Boards instruction of August 13, 2013 to submit names of unbiased insurance consultants for the Board to choose if desired. Motion to table action was seconded by Edward Smith.

Roll call to table action: John Finlayson—No, Paul Simpson—Yes, Edward Smith—Yes, John Smith---Yes, Chris Tull---No. Motion to table passed.
