SELMER BEER BOARD FOLLOWING THE 7:00 REGULAR BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN MEETING NOVEMBER 12, 2013 IN SELMER CITY HALL.

The Selmer Beer Board was called into session by Mayor David Robinson for the purpose of action concerning a Beer Permit violation at Super Way – CITGO, 1470 E Poplar Ave., Selmer, Tennessee 38375.

Beer Board members present were: John Finlayson, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith, John Smith and Chris Tull.

Chief Neal Burks stated that on August 29th Drug Agent Kim Holley and Agent Jamie Lowrance purchased a 6 pack of beer through a minor informant from Mr. Patel at Super Way - CITGO, 1470 E. Poplar Ave., Selmer, Tn. and charged the business accordingly as selling to a minor. It was noted that this was the owner and operators first violation.

Attorney Abernathy announced that he could not take part in the issue in any way, for or against, due to his attorney client relationship with the Patel's on other business issues.

Motion was made by John Smith to suspend the sale of beer at this location for a period of thirty days as in keeping with all previous first time violators. Motion seconded by Edward Smith.
