

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session February 10, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor John Smith presided with all five Board of Aldermen as follows: John Finlayson, Johnny Norris, Paul Simpson, Edward Smith and Chris Tull.

The meeting opened with prayer by Jetta Forsythe followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Tom Evans.

Motion by Chris Tull and seconded by John Finlayson to approve the January 13, 2015 minutes. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Edward Smith and seconded by Paul Simpson to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on second reading an ordinance adopting the 2009 Edition of the International Energy Conservation Code. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd reading passed. (Ordinance No 646)

Motion by Paul Simpson and seconded by John Finlayson to pass on first reading an ordinance to rezone parcels 14.03, 14.02, 14.01, Group B, Map 80N of the October 2012 McNairy County Tax Map, parcels lying between Walnut St. and Holly St. along Peach Ave., from the present B1 (General Business) to R2(Medium Density Residential). All five voted yes. Motion carried. 1st reading passed.

Motion by Edward Smith to appoint Easton Knight to fill the vacancy of Dr. Rascoe Rhea on the Selmer Municipal/Regional Planning Commission. Motion seconded by Paul Simpson. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Chris Tull to adopt a resolution authorizing the Town of Selmer to purchase prepaid natural gas for a 15-year period at index minus 12 cents through TEAC (Tennessee Energy Acquisition Corporation). Motion seconded by Johnny Norris. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Chris Tull to adopt a resolution approving filing an application for 2014 Home Grant with THDA in an amount of \$500,000.00. Motion seconded by Edward Smith. All five voted yes. Motion carried.
