

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session July 14, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall.

Mayor John Smith presided.

Board of Aldermen Present: Johnny Norris, Edward Smith, and Chris Tull.

Absent: John Finlayson and Paul Simpson.

Mayor John Smith called the meeting to order and Pastor Gregg Worthy of First Christian Church opened with prayer followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Jim Replogle.

Motion by Chris Tull and seconded by Johnny Norris to approve the minutes of last month. All three Board of Aldermen voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by Edward Smith to approve the financial statement. All three Board of Aldermen voted yes. Motion carried.

Department reports were given.
