

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session May 14th, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor John Smith was present with four Board of Aldermen: John Austin, John Finlayson, J. T. Hawkins, Johnny Norris. Troy Moore was absent.

The meeting opened with prayer by Russell Ingle followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Street Superintendent Raymond Ouellette.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by J.T Hawkins to accept the April 2019 financial statement.

Department reports were given.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by John Finlayson to pass the first reading of an ordinance to amend Title 3, Chapter 1, Section 3-108 of the Selmer Municipal Code relative to the Court Costs.

All four present voted yes.

Motion carried.

Motion by J. T. Hawkins to approve having a special called meeting on June 24th at 4:30 P.M. in Selmer City Hall for the purpose of having the second reading of the 2019-2020 Budget Ordinance and the second reading of an Ordinance amending the FY 2019 Budget. Motion seconded by Johnny Norris.

All four present voted yes.

Motion carried.

Lonnie King addressed the Board to asked if there were plans to rezone the old Armory building on W Cherry Ave. to a Commercial Zone due to hearing a rumor that a "Halfway House" might be put in the building. He ask that in the event that this rumor were true that the zoning change not be allowed. He stated that he, as a surrounding property owner, wanted the zoning to stay restricted and did not want a change! No one in the room acknowledged having any knowledge of this possibility.
