

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session February 11, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor John Smith and all five Board of Aldermen were present as follows: John Austin, John Finlayson, J.T. Hawkins, Johnny Norris, and Willie Sain.

The meeting opened with prayer by J. T. Hawkins followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Kim Holley.

Motion by J. T. Hawkins and seconded by John Austin to adopt the minutes of January 2020. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by John Finlayson to accept the financial statement for January 2020. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Department reports were given.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by Willie Sain to approve the request of Selmer Fire Department to apply for 3 different AFG Grants with a total match of \$9,750.00 from the town.

All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by J.T. Hawkins to accept 2.8 acres off of Florence Avenue across from Selmer Townhouse Apartments from the Boy Scout Troop and Selmer Lions Club. Motion seconded by John Austin. Attorney Abernathy reported that in researching the deed stipulations this land must be used for a playground.

All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Attorney Abernathy recommended that the Mayor and Board consider a special called meeting for any discussion of Police Chief Neal Burk's case.
