

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session March 10,2020 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor John Smith and all five Board of Aldermen were present as follows: John Austin, John Finlayson, J. T. Hawkins, Johnny Norris and Willie Sain.

The meeting opened with prayer by Street Superintendent Ray Ouellette followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by John Finlayson.

Motion by J. T. Hawkins and seconded by John Austin to adopt the minutes of February, 2020. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by Willie Sain to accept the financial statement. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Department reports were given.

Motion by J. T. Hawkins and seconded by John Finlayson to approve the request of Selmer Fire Department to apply for 3 different grants with no required match by the Town of Selmer as follows: Fire House Sub Grant approximately \$25,000.00, The Governor Highway Safety Grant approximately \$20,000.00, and The State Fire Marshall Grant approximately \$10,000.00.

All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by John Finlayson to adopt on first reading an Ordinance amending Chapter 1, Section 13, Part 107 (Ordinance No. 13-107) to include a \$250.00 charge to persons failing to use the Bulk Pickup on the regular scheduled quarterly days.

All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris to adopt a Resolution authorizing the sale and providing the details of not to exceed \$7,600,000.00 General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2020 of the Town of Selmer and providing refunding for the levy of Ad Valorem Taxes in connection therewith. Motion seconded by John Finlayson.

All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by J. T. Hawkins to establish an updated Occupational Safety and Health Program Plan, devise rules and regulations and provide a Safety Director and implementation of the plan.

Motion seconded by Willie Sain.

All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris to contribute \$1,000.00 towards a sponsorship for the 1st Annual McNairy County BBQ Festival. Motion seconded by J. T. Hawkins. John Austin--yes, John Finlayson---Passed, J. T. Hawkins--yes, Johnny Norris---yes, Willie Sain---yes.

Motion carried.
