

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session May 11, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall. Mayor John Smith and all five Board of Aldermen were present as follows: John Austin, John Finlayson, J. T. Hawkins, Johnny Norris, and Willie Sain.

The meeting opened with prayer by J. T. Hawkins followed by the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America led by Johnny Norris.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by J. T. Hawkins to approve the minutes of April, 2021. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by John Finlayson and seconded by Johnny Norris to accept the financial statement of April, 2021. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by Willie Sain to pass on second reading an ordinance amending the text of the Selmer Municipal Zoning ordinance removing Automobile Parking as a permitted use in the B2 (Central Business) district while retaining the use as an accessory use. All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd reading passed. Ordinance No. 685 passed.

Motion by John Austin and seconded by Willie Sain to pass on second reading an Ordinance amending the official Zoning Map of Selmer, Tennessee to rezone the herein described properties (Parcel 16.01 on McNairy County Tax Map 100L and parcel 76.00 on McNairy County Tax Map 100 as of March 2021) along Jones Street and R-1 (Low Density Residential) to B-1 (General Business). All five voted yes. Motion carried. 2nd Reading passed. Ordinance No. 686 passed.

Motion by Johnny Norris and seconded by Willie Sain to approve a special called meeting on June 29th at 5:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall for the purpose of the 2nd Reading of the 2021-2022 Budget Ordinance and the 2nd Reading of an Ordinance amending the 2021 FY Budget. All five voted yes. Motion carried.

Candy Garrison introduced herself as a 7th District McNairy County Commissioner promoting Selmer and McNairy County on her Face Book Page encouraged everyone to participate in her "5 Fast Facts" postings about McNairy County. She later made a picture of the Mayor and Board to be displayed on her "Likes & Shares".
