

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen met in regular session August 10, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. in Selmer City Hall.

Mayor John Smith and the Board of Aldermen were present as follows:

John Austin, John Finlayson, Johnny Norris, and Willie Sain. J. T. Hawkins was absent.

The meeting opened with prayer by Raymond Ouellette followed with the pledge of allegiance to the United States flag of America let by Jim Replogle.

Motion by John Austin to accept the minutes of July, 2021. Motion seconded by Willie Sain. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnny Norris to accept the financial statement for July, 2021. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Department reports were given.

Motion by Johnny Norris to adopt a resolution authorizing an application to the Tennessee Department of Transportation for the Multimodal Access Grant committing a 5% match of the million dollar project budget as well as continued facility maintenance, and that the Mayor be authorized to sign all necessary assurances, agreements or contracts required for TDOT funding. Motion seconded by John Finlayson. All four present voted yes. Motion carried.

Ed Huggins of 432 E. Poplar Ave. addressed the Board concerning unsightly properties. He again brought pictures and questioned that the 234 Oak Street property was discussed at the March meeting and had been well over ninety days and it was still in the same terrible shape.

He further addressed concerns over the need to clean up and beautify the properties across from Selmer's largest factory on Peach Ave. He expressed concerns that the town would spend a million dollars on the north Selmer park and ignore these needs.

Rodney Murray addressed the Board concerning the need for the police department to enforce the "Noise Laws". He complained that he had spoken with Chief Kin Holley and that nothing had changed. He informed that where he lived off Peach Ave. was so bad that his wife on occasion had been unable to talk on the telephone. He further stated the laws concerning vehicles were not being enforced from colored head lights, no bumpers, no head lights, underbody speakers, loud mufflers, bumper heights and quoted the State law concerning some violations. He asked what laws that Chief Holley was going to enforce.. Kim Holley said that tickets had been written and that these issues would be addressed when they caught them, but could not set an officer out just to catch this.
